

- Robert F. Shelby, Jr., 1964 (2nd term of service)
- Mike Varn, 1979 (Not a seminarian, but graduated from Southern Seminary)
- Micah Kearney, 2014 (1st call from Southern Seminary)
- Interim, John Propst...Guess what Seminary? Correct!

Looks like over 50% of our pastors have graduated from Southern Seminary and were "First-called" to Holy Comforter.

Did I also happen to mention that 100% graduated from Lenoir-Rhyne? Do we see a trend developing?
