Grace and peace,

As most of you are likely aware by now, this past month our council approved a new marriage policy for Holy Comforter, the most noticeable change being the allowance of the pastor to officiate at same-gender weddings. I recognize that this has been received with mixed feelings from the congregation, but I want to take my time to commend both the council and the congregation for the way in which they have carried themselves throughout this process. It has been apparent to me that the folks who have voiced their opinions both publicly and to me have wrestled with looking for a faithful response to the issue. While doing so, folks have been respectful of one another, most noticeably those with views that differ from their own. It has been a beautiful witness of Christian community, especially in times of disagreement, and I both thank you and am proud of you for the ways in which you have conducted yourselves.

I want to especially commend our church council on their faithful diligence throughout the discernment of this new marriage policy. They approached the conversation faithfully and prayerfully, and with the intention to put aside their personal views in order to discern what was best for the congregation and our mission together. For a conversation that has generated both passionate and polarizing conversation in our culture, that is an impressive feat, and I commend them for that.

I myself have kept quiet in our discussion to allow all points of view to be shared. I do want you to know that I am in favor of this decision for reasons that have to do with biblical scholarship, our church's traditional teachings on marriage, and our call to compassion. I would be happy to talk about this with anyone, and perhaps to offer a class or discussion group if there is further interest to do so.

Again, let me end by thanking you for using your gifts of listening to one another and respecting one another both throughout this process and as a congregation in general. I am glad to be your pastor, and look forward to continuing to be in ministry and mission with you all in Christ's name.
